

This document reviews the significant enhancements to DentaLab for QuickBooks (DQB) and DentalRx in the 2023 June Release 1.74 based on requests and suggestions from users of the system as well as the technical support staff.

DQB and DentalRx: Fundamentals for Compatibility and Security

To maintain compatibility with the latest software from the major providers such as Microsoft for Windows 11 and the .Net Framework and Intuit for QuickBooks, we have applied the technical changes required.

In addition, there are continual upgrades to internet security measures that are needed to guard against theft of information, ransomware, and other dangers.

DQB Advanced Installer

For installation of both the licensed versions of our software and trials/demos, we now have a new utility called Advanced Installer. This tool has been designed to handle conflicts with other SQL based software for installation of the SQL database and to provide timely messages to you from our servers whenever needed.

These updates are for both standard and starter versions of DQB:

DQB Cases to be Shipped Report: New Indicators to Exclude Cases

The Cases to be Shipped report is based on reporting cases within a range of planned ship dates vs actual shipped status. The criteria section at top has added indicators you can check to exclude cases if marked as:

- Finished
- Invoiced
- On Hold

DQB/QB Online Field Lengths Expanded

For QB Online versions, the field lengths were standardized and expanded. Some of these have been further expanded. DQB and its connector program have been adjusted for these.

Although they can be much larger, we continue to recommend that you limit the length of the primary search fields such as customer name and item name.

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The following is for only the standard version of DQB:

DQB DentalRx Case Counts by Status

This new graph is similar to the top left dashboard in the standard version of DQB to show case counts by status. You can select the range of received dates to include only cases with DRX in the Entry By field indicating the case was received via DentalRx.

The five statuses are:

Prebooked
Open in Lab
Out for Try-in
On Hold
Finished

It will be available in the Case Report menu for DentalRx. It can also be added to the top Favorites menu.

DQB Case Reports Menu: DentalRx set

The Case Report menu has been changed to add a new submenu for the options related to DentalRx cases. It will include:

- DentalRx Cases report
- DentalRx Case Counts graph

Additional DQB Features for DentalRx Cases:

We have had several requests from those labs offering DentalRx to be alerted that cases have been received via the portal so they can be promptly reviewed and scheduled into the workflow. The requests to have an email for each one received would not be practical as the count increases.

If someone wants to get the DentalRx cases scheduled and into the workflow, either of these would work well and staff can be trained to look for them.

1. DentalRx Cases option in the Apps menu (in DQB Standard only)
2. Case List with Entry By criteria DRX

NOTE:

When DentalRx cases are first entered into DQB, the entered date is set to the current date, the status is set to On Hold, the entry by is set to DRX. Typically once the case is reviewed and scheduled, the status is changed to Open/In Lab.

Here are further enhancements to help assure DRX cases are reviewed and processed.

Case Reports Menu: Cases by Date and Status Report

Since the Cases by Date and Status report is highly used, we have added an indicator in the right frame below the indicators for remake and adjustment only for:

Show DentalRx Cases Only

If the indicator is set on, working with the other criteria, only those cases with DRX in the Entry By field are included in the report.

Cases Menu: New DentalRx Cases

For the case entry/list set we have added: New DentalRx Cases.
This shows the case list with only the new not yet processed DentalRx cases that have entry by DRX and status On Hold.

Case Reports Menu: DentalRx Cases

In the Cases By set, we have added a new report: DentalRx Cases

Included in the criteria at top are:

Received Date - two calendars for date range, initialized to current date, can be edited

Case Status – initialized to On Hold, can be edited

The report will include cases with entry by DRX and the selected criteria.

Columns: Case #, Status, Received, Requested, Doctor, Patient, Pan
Sort by: Case # ascending
End of report: Case Count

Notifications/Internal Report: DentalRx Cases

A version of above report including all cases with entry by DRX with the On Hold status is available for automatic scheduling and sending via email using the Notifications supplement for internal reports to lab management.

DentalRx: Web Storage for Digital Files

This is a new option to provide for web storage of digital files for access by other participants in workflow. This includes a protocol for naming folders:

- Level 1: Customer Name
- Level 2: Patient Name – Case #

You can choose the web location such as Amazon, Google.

We will continue to store and provide access in DQB Images and Documents but also direct digital files transmitted via DentalRx to the appropriate folder in the web location.
